ABSTRACT

An Exploration Play for Cambrian Helium in the Rome Trough of Kentucky and Tennessee

Four wells in Central Kentucky have penetrated Cambrian Age sediments with natural gas with commercial concentrations of helium associated with the gas. The utilization of documented surface geology, subsurface geology, and incorporation of gravity and magnetic information has identified numerous prospects and leads that offer drilling opportunities for not only helium but also oil and natural gas. The posted price of \$86 per MCF helium offers significant value in a depressed oil and gas market.
